How to Register

- For Senior Boys who want to have a GUI/GolfNet handicap, full personal insurance and membership in Men's Club (which allows entry into senior competitions, e.g. weekend competitions). The payment procedure is as follows:
 - 1. Pay €200 to the management company, Pat / Cathal Donnelan. This allows you to play on the course. Please fill out any forms that they may ask you to complete.
 - 2. Pay €60 into the Men's Competition Fee box in an envelope supplied there with Name, wording 'Junior Membership', amount paid, contact telephone number.
 - 3. Fill out the Junior Registration Form from me.
 - 4. Put at least €20 in an envelope into the Competitions Fee Box to cover for Senior Competition entries if you intend on playing in them. Money is recorded on the Men's computer system.
 - 5. Failure to comply will result in Men's Committee removing name from computer system and ban from playing any Bearna and other course competitions.
- For Juniors / Cadets GUI membership is covered, you are required to
 - 1. Pay €200 to the management company, Pat/Cathal. This allows you to play on the course. Please fill out any forms that they may ask you to complete.
 - 2. Pay €20 into the Men's Competition Fee box in an envelope supplied there with Name, wording 'Junior Membership', amount paid, contact telephone number.
 - 3. Fill out the Junior Registration Form from me.
