Please note that Junior Golf will recommence **Sunday May 10th at 5.00PM.**

This first session will be preceded by a short meeting (on the putting green, weather permitting, or in the Main Clubhouse Foyer). All Juniors and a parent are asked to attend. The main issues for discussion is to get feedback from all on **what is desired / expected** from Junior Golf and how we can together achieve those. (**Beginners, Experienced Juniors, Age Groups, Competitions, Junior & CONGU handicaps etc., Funding of Prizes and General Organization etc.**)

Junior Golf is currently open to:

1. All children of *Family Members* who have been *nominated* by their parents and are at least 12 years of age.
2. All children of *Full Members* (Lady or Gent) and *on payment of the Junior Subscription* to the Directors and are at least 12 years of age.

These criteria are laid down by the Directors and are not under the control of the Ladies or Gents Clubs.

On Sunday evenings, we welcome Juniors who have not played before. Provided they have access to golf clubs, we will show them the basics of the game and accompany them around a short course as appropriate. We hope to organize more formal instruction later on.

We also welcome back the Juniors who were active last year. Given the tremendous improvement we saw during the year, I'm sure we will have a big turn out. Obviously those less active Juniors last year are also welcome.

Any Adult member (Lady or Gent) who is willing to help out on some Sunday evenings would be very welcome and much appreciated.
