

Men's Fourball Match Play 2009

Men's Fourball Match Play Rules 2009

1. **Competition Handicap:**

Competitors must play off their lowest handicap held by them in the year of the event.

The lowest handicapped player goes to scratch. The other players then play off $\frac{3}{4}$ the difference between their competition handicap and that of the lowest player. Shots are then taken in accordance to the course stroke indexes.

All players attention is drawn to Rule of Golf "6.2a" regarding his responsibility to ensure that he plays off his correct handicap and declares same to his opponent prior on the commencement of play.

2. Players on the top of the draw are responsible for contacting their opponent and have the honour on the 1st tee.

3. Play shall be from the **White** markers.

4. The Entry Fee is **€10**. Money will be deducted from your account after the draw has been made. It is essential therefore to have your account up to date

5. Deadlines for the completion of matches **will** be strictly enforced. The name of the winning player must be entered on the draw sheet by the evening of the completion date for that round of the competition.
